

Understand the difference...

Earth

Usually refers to the entire planet.

“I wouldn’t date you if you were the last man on Earth”



Ground

The land underneath you, outside of your home.

It may be flat or hilly.

“When she jumped up, her feet left the ground.”



Soil

Usually refers to dirt. (Think of planting vegetables in a garden.)

“The soil was perfect for growing sunflowers.”



Floor

The material under your feet that you are standing on, usually inside a home or building. (Think of wood, stone, tile, carpet. etc.)

“The little boy spilled his cereal all over the kitchen floor”
